**Jonathan Kaper, M.D.** is senior vice president and chief medical officer for Beaumont Hospital, Trenton, a 193-bed, full-service teaching hospital which is part of Beaumont Health, Michigan's largest health care system, based on inpatient admissions and net patient revenue. He also serves as the hospital's patient safety officer.

Dr. Kaper was appointed chief medical officer at Beaumont, Trenton in 2015. He closely collaborates with medical and hospital leadership, including its Medical Executive Committee, hospital president and elected chief of staff. Dr. Kaper is responsible for overall hospital performance and developing the vision and strategic plan for clinical activities. As the hospital's patient safety officer, he oversees site-related patient safety and quality activities.

Dr. Kaper served as the chief of Anesthesia at Beaumont, Trenton from 2011-2014. Prior to that, he was the medical director of Oakwood Southshore Ambulatory Center. He has been recognized by his peers as a recipient of the "Physician of the Year" award in 2013 and "Physician of the Quarter" in 2012. He has also served as the perioperative medical director and vice chief of Anesthesia at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital in Ann Arbor.

Dr. Kaper earned his bachelor's degree from Northwestern University and his medical degree from the University of Cincinnati. He completed his residency training at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center in Boston.

Beaumont Health is a not-for-profit organization formed in 2014 by Beaumont Health System, Botsford Hospital and Oakwood Healthcare to provide patients and families with compassionate, extraordinary care, no matter where they live in Southeast Michigan.
